Clarence Campbell -- Kankakee Visitation for Clarence "Bud" Campbell, 86, of Kankakee, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where private services will be held Saturday. The Revs. R. David Reynolds and Carl Johnston will officiate. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or to Trinity United Methodist Church, where he was an active member for 61 years. He died Sunday (Dec. 23, 2007) at the Miller Center. Mr. Campbell built and remodeled homes and worked as a heavy equipment mechanic. He retired from the city of Kankakee, where he was the building inspector. He was born Jan. 19, 1921, in Des Moines, Iowa, the son of Clarence and Carrie Tibbie Campbell. He was a graduate of Manteno High School. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps, serving during World War II in the European Theatre of Operations. On April 1, 1944 his plane went down over France and he spent the rest of the war as a German prisoner. He was involved with the Exchange Club, and an active member of the Northern Mustang Corral Club and the Kankakee Valley Vintage Car Club. He enjoyed exploring his country. Surviving are his wife, the former Evelyn Johnston, whom he married April 11, 1947, at Trinity United Methodist Church; one son and daughter-in-law, James and Lucy Campbell of Colfax, Calif.; two daughters and one son-in-law, Jean and Troy Pombert of Tracy, Calif., Marilyn Campbell of Palos Heights; seven grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, one great-great-grandson; and one sister, Carolyn Johnson of

Taylorville. Deceased are one daughter, Linda Campbell; and one sister, Mary Drazy.
