Clarence J. Robinson, 88, of Manteno, formerly of Bradley, passed away on Wednesday, March 11, 2015 at Heritage Woods in Manteno. He was born on November 7, 1926 in Bradley to Clarence D. and Opal F. Brumfield Robinson. Clarence married Helen E. Stowe on October 20, 1951 in Bradley.

Clarence was an employee of Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School and retired in 1986. He formerly worked at Gould National Battery. He had done handyman work since his retirement. For nine years, Clarence and his wife spent alternating months at Henderson Settlement in Frakes, Kentucky as mission volunteers.
