Courtney Kellogg Wojcik, 36, of Chicago, and formerly of Kankakee, passed away Monday (Aug. 25, 2014) at the home of her parents in Kankakee.

Courtney earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign's College of Fine and Applied Arts' department of dance. While there, she helped form a dance company in which she danced and choreographed. Upon graduating, she moved to Detroit, Mich., where she

helped form another dance company and furthered her professional dance career. After returning to Chicago she became certified in various fitness disciplines, including gyrotonics instruction.

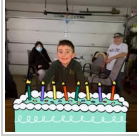

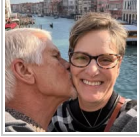
