“ Jeanette & Mary, Cindy became a close friend of mine when I lived in Champaign-Urbana in the 1980s. When I moved away we stayed in touch with phone calls and letters. This friendship continued when I moved overseas 20 years ago. I still have all of her letters and beautiful cards.

Cindy's letters stopped arriving around 2005 and I could no longer reach her by phone in Urbana at her Florida Avenue address. I was unable to track her, or any of her relatives, down, although I tried; I didn't know either of your surnames, and I could find no trace of your mom in Kankakee through directory assistance. I was very worried about her, but assumed she had passed away suddenly, since it was NOT Cindy's style to disappear or forget people. Did her letters stop because she was too ill to write in the last ten years, or perhaps she lost my address during her move to a new location?

Cindy was a very cherished friend. She talked often about all of you. I remember many of our conversations - characterised by warmth, an eye for detail, good humor, and, most of all, her love and appreciation for others, which she struggled - but still managed eloquently - to express. I think about her often, remember her very fondly, and miss her very, very much.
