



## Dale Kiedaisch

June 23, 1948 - December 10, 2009

Dale W. Kiedaisch, 61, of Manteno, died Thursday (Dec. 10, 2009) at Riverside Medical Center, after an extended illness. A memorial visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Manteno, where memorial services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday. The Rev. Jack McCormick will officiate. Memorials may be made to the American Diabetes Foundation or to the American Heart Association. Mr. Kiedaisch was a certified public accountant and the owner of Dale W. Kiedaisch, CPA. He was born June 23, 1948, in Kankakee, the son of Walter and Myrna Allers Kiedaisch. He received a bachelor of science degree in accounting in 1971 from Illinois State University. He was a member of Wesley United Methodist Church in Bradley. He had also been a member of the Manteno School Board for 12 years, a member of the Manteno Rotary Club and a member of the Chamber of Commerce in Manteno, where he was a former treasurer. He enjoyed the Bears, Cubs, music and reading. Surviving are his wife, the former Janice E. Goodwin, of Manteno, whom he married June 28, 1969, at Wesley United Methodist Church; one son and daughter-in-law, Joel and Jennifer Kiedaisch of Chicago; two daughters and sons-in-law, Shelley and Jason Lingo of Manteno, Kari and Ben Karch of Normal; six grandchildren, Jackson and Charles Kiedaisch and future brother/sister Kiedaisch; Riley, Corliss and Miranda Lingo, and Kaitlyn Karch; his parents of Manteno; and two sisters and one brother-in-law, Donna Kiedaisch, and Diane and Gary Preston, all of Manteno.
