Dale E. Noble, age 85 of Bourbonnais, formerly of Rockville Township, passed away Saturday, February 27, 2021 at Miller Healthcare Center, Kankakee. He was born September 13, 1935 in Kankakee, the son of Charles N. and Valeria (Reed) Noble. Dale married Donna Vrolyk on June 20, 1958 at Wichert Reformed Church.

Dale was a lifelong farmer in Rockville Township on the land that was in his family since purchased from the government. He graduated from the University of Illinois where he earned his private pilot license.
