Ed Williams -- Kankakee Dale E. "Ed" Williams Jr., 53, of Kankakee, died Wednesday (Jan. 11, 2006) at his home. Visitation will be from 3-8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Saturday at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church. Rev. Dennis Settles will officiate. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery. Mr. Williams started working for the U.S. Postal Service in 1974 and had been the postmaster in Manteno since Oct. 25, 1986. He was born June 5, 1952, in Kankakee, the son of Dale E. Sr. and Jean Bertrand Williams. He was a member of St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, where he was a Eucharistic Minister, past president of the PTO and served on the parish board and the credit union board. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and NAPUS. He served on the Kankakee County Federal Employee Federal Credit Union Board and was a past Rotarian. He enjoyed the outdoors, sunshine, running and exercising, traveling and bowling. He was competitive in sports. Surviving are his wife, the former Mary Riley, whom he married Dec. 16, 1972 at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church; three sons and two daughters-in-law, Matthew and Renee Williams of Manteno, Michael and Laura Williams of Aurora and Max Williams of Kankakee; his parents of Kankakee; one sister and brother-in-law, Patty and Mike Bauer of Lizton, Ind.; three brothers and sisters-in-law, Robert and Donna Williams of London, Ky., Jim and Nancy Williams of Richardson, Texas, Andy and Kelly Williams of Aurora; one grandson; and many nieces, nephews and godchildren.

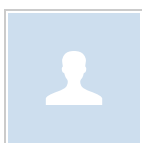
