



Daniel Nugent

March 12, 1943 - April 20, 2005

Visitation for Daniel W. Nugent, 62, of Manteno, will be from 2-8 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Monday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais, where he was a member. His brother, Father Tony Nugent, will officiate. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Bishop McNamara High School or to Maternity BVM Elementary School. He died Wednesday (April 20, 2005) at his home. Mr. Nugent was a lifelong farmer in the Manteno area. He was born March 12, 1943, in Joliet, the son of Leo and Joan Carlos Nugent. His father is deceased. Surviving are his wife, the former Mary Christiansen, whom he married Jan. 27, 1968, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, Kankakee; three sons and one daughter-in-law, Matt and Staci Nugent of Manteno, Joe Nugent and his friend, Charlotte Hansing of Kankakee, Ryan Nugent of Manteno; one daughter and son-in-law, Natalie and Bill Netherton of Bourbonnais; his mother of Manteno; two sisters and brothers-in-law, Donna and Virgil Bertrand of Manteno, Karen and Chuck Cassidy of Greensboro, Ga.; three brothers and two sisters-in-law, Fr. Anthony Nugent of Plainfield, Kevin and Janis Nugent, Tim and Yvette Nugent, all of Manteno; four grandchildren, Sydnie and Sophia Nugent and Abbie and Wilson Netherton; special in-laws, Bonnie and Dale Milton of Manteno, Judy and Tom Laurent of Martinton; mother-in-law, Virginia Christiansen of Kankakee; and several nieces and nephews. Two brothers, Lavern and Joel Nugent, are deceased. Mr. Nugent was on the board

of directors for the Manteno Farmers Elevator for 25 years and a member of the Alano Club in Kankakee. He devoted his life to family, farming and faith.

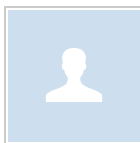
