Danute "Diane" Sheehan, age 82, of Kankakee passed away Saturday, March 9, 2024 at Ascension St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee. She was born July 21, 1941 in Vilnius, Lithuania, the daughter of Jozas & Elena Pacauskas. Diane married Joseph Sheehan on May 18, 1974 at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee.

Diane worked in the office of Lowe Seed and Central Adjustment Bureau for many years before retiring. She was an avid Chicago Cubs fan and cat lover. She grew up a Green Bay Packers fan but found the light and became a Chicago Bears fan. She also enjoyed gardening at home.

She was a parishioner of St. John Paul II for many years. Diane was very active within the church including serving as a lector and planting flowers. She was the former Vice President of the CCW, voted CCW Woman of the Year and served on the Parish Council Board, where she also was the former Vice President.
