Her husband, Willard Nelson, whom she married Oct. 29, 1937, in Kankakee, is deceased. She was a volunteer at St. Mary's Hospital for 15 years and did volunteer work at the Kankakee Historical Society. She was a member of St. Patrick's CCW, the Kankakee Book Club and Kankakee Woman's Club. Surviving are one daughter, Kristina Nelson of Boulder, Colo.; one sister, Vivian Danca of Bradley; 10 nieces and nephews. One sister, Pearl Duffy, is deceased.
