Darrell Poland -- Kankakee Visitation for Darrell T. Poland, 82, of Kankakee, will be from 9 a.m. Friday until the 11 a.m. funeral services at Zion Lutheran Church in Bonfield. Mr. Poland was a civil engineer for the Illinois Department of Transportation for 31 years, retiring in 1984. He was born May 9, 1924, in Lowell, the son of Herman Otis and Phoebe Grace Speakman Poland. He served during World War II in the U.S. Navy. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Bonfield, enjoyed using the scroll saw to make crafts, woodworking and reading. Surviving are his wife, the former Edith Stortz, whom he married June 9, 1957, in Roanoke, Illinois; two sons and one daughter-in-law, Mark and Nancy Poland of Limestone, Brian Poland of Hammond, Ind.; three grandchildren, Stephanie Poland, Zachary Poland and Christopher Poland; one sister, Helene Poland of Tonica; and one brother and sister-in-law, Lyle and Carol Poland of Decatur. One brother, Norman, is deceased.
