David Lee LaRocque, 69, of Bourbonnais, passed away on Tuesday, October 16th, 2018. Born February 1st, 1949, in Kankakee to Edwin LaRocque and Audrey Hiser, David graduated from Bishop McNamara High School with the class of 1967. 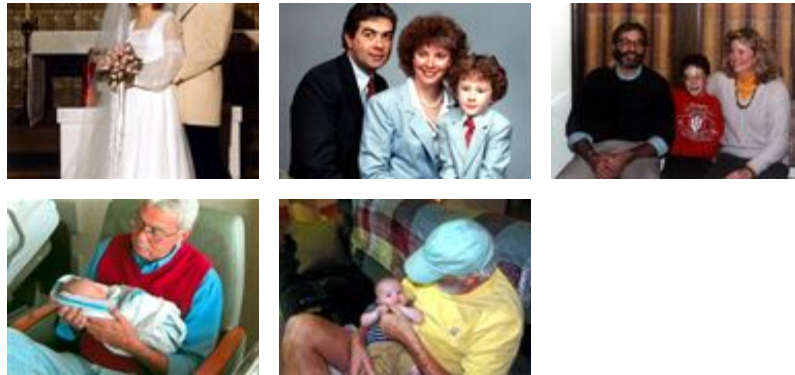
