David Walters -- Bradley David Jr. Walters, 89, of Bradley, died Thursday (Feb. 28, 2008) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday. Pastor Patty Heath will officiate.
