Deanna L Ream, 83, of Saint Anne, passed away Tuesday, January 23rd at Miller Rehabilitation Center.

She was born September 3rd, 1940, in Kankakee, a daughter of Herbert and Edna (Beaupre) Reiniche.

Deanna married Arthur E Prairie on June 27, 1959, in Bradley. He preceded her in death on May 25, 2002. She was also preceded in death by her parents and two sisters, Marjorie Elliott, and Claire Meadows.

Surviving is her husband, Vernon Ream, whom she married on January 5, 2008. attending twice-daily gospel services, or sitting around a bonfire, enjoying a fish fry with friends while listening to their stories.
