

Dell Ford

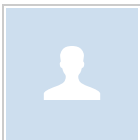
August 17, 1918 - May 5, 2010

Dell Ford, 91, of Bradley, died Wednesday (May 5, 2010) in the emergency room at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, where services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday.
