Delmar G. "Don" Pruitt, 85, of Watseka, formerly of Kankakee, died Monday (Nov. 8, 2010) at Watseka Rehab and Health Care Center, where he resided for one week. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais, where funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Friday. The Rev. Lance Hurley will officiate.
