I remember 1 night after BINGO Boris not only towed me out during a snowstorm in the day, but they hadn't called off Bingo and I was taking a friend home off of Otto road after Bingo and got stuck for the second time, in the same day. Bingo was always a conversational event where Boris always talked about his JuJu bringing him luck. Boris yelled at me for even attempting to take friend home, but never even charge me. I remember calling my twin In Mississippi after Boris accident to inform her and she couldn't believe it. She wrote a letter to Dolores, the last one she ever wrote, reassuring Dolores that Pops was going to pull through and he'd be ok. Boris accident happened on the date of my fathers death and she shared her feelings with Dolores in her letter. My twin and Boris died the exact same day 6-20-87. Cheryl coming to my sister's wake the night of the day Boris was buried and said how much he enjoyed Bingo and enjoying our company. When Dolores got the last letter Carol wrote, Dolores called me, the day after twin was buried and gave me the letter. What a wonderful and caring person Dolores was.
