Dennis L. "Denny" Lottinville, age 81, of Bourbonnais embarked on his final journey Friday, January 14, 2022 at Central DuPage Hospital. 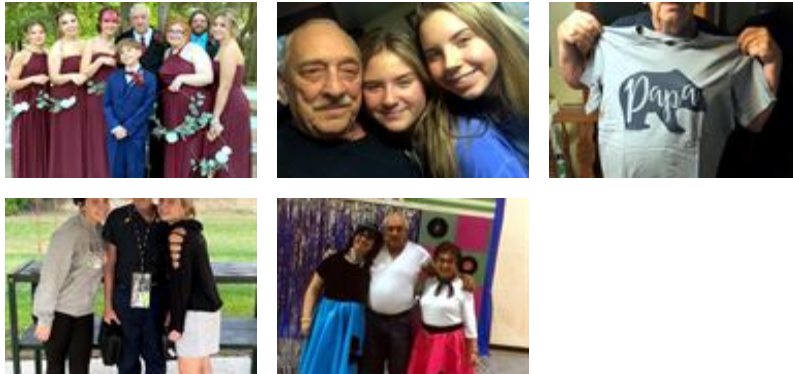

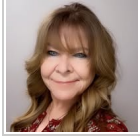
