Dianne K. Gordon, 77, of Bourbonnais, passed away at her home on Saturday, October 21, 2023. Dianne was born on June 18, 1946, in Kankakee, the daughter of Harold and Marjorie (Cheffer) Jensen.

Dianne married Dale Gordon on April 23, 1966, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee. Dianne went to work right away after high school at People's Bank of Kankakee County. Starting off as teller she worked very diligently over her 44-year career; Dianne worked all the way up to Vice President and Controller of People's Bank before retiring on January 1, 2008. Dianne was an avid golfer and was a four time Women's Club Champion at the Kankakee Elk's Country Club. She recorded 3 holes in one throughout her life. Dianne was a longtime supporter of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital and volunteered at St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee for many years. Most of all Dianne enjoyed spending time with her family and cheering for her grandchildren at all their sporting events. Dianne was a member of Maternity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Church in Bourbonnais.
