Dolores B. Capriotti, age 86, of Bourbonnais, passed away Wednesday, November 25, 2020 at Citadel of Bourbonnais.

She was born February 1, 1934 in Chicago Heights, the daughter of James & Helen Wolny Caperelli.

Dolores married Fred H. Capriotti Sr. on February 12, 1955. He preceded her in death on April 10, 2003.

Dolores was a retired restaurant owner specializing in Italian cuisine. She was an accomplished pianist. Dolores loved her grandchildren and spending time with her family.

Surviving are two sons and two daughters-in-law, Fred Jr. & Jeanne Capriotti of Bourbonnais and Jay & Kelly Capriotti of Rochester; one daughter and one son-in-law, Julie & David Highland of Kankakee; ten grandchildren, Tony Capriotti, Jimmy Capriotti, Clara Capriotti, Ashley Highland Patchett, Matthew Highland, Nicolette Highland, Jasper Capriotti, Nicholas Capriotti, Jillian Capriotti, and Gianna Capriotti; and 5 great-grandchildren.
