



Dolores "Do" LeBeau

September 19, 1930 - February 8, 2016

Dolores "Do" M. LeBeau, 85, of Bourbonnais, passed away Monday (Feb. 8, 2016) at Faith Place, Danforth.

She was born Sept. 19, 1930, in Bourbonnais, the daughter of David and Lena LaBran Green. Dolores married Donald LeBeau on Jan. 27, 1951, at Maternity BVM Church, Bourbonnais. He preceded her in death on Dec. 5, 1992.

Dolores was a homemaker, and had formerly worked as the transportation director for the Bourbonnais School District. She had helped start a homeless shelter in Boston and was active in girls softball in Bourbonnais. She was a graduate of Notre Dame Convent, Bourbonnais, and was a member of Maternity BVM Church.

In addition to her husband, preceding her in death were her parents; a son, Donald; a daughter, Nanette; brother, Donald Green; great-grandson, Jacob Antros; and sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Orville and Cleo Estill.

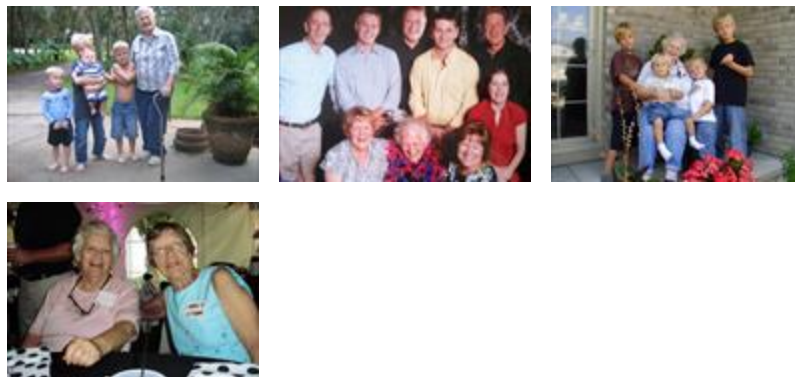

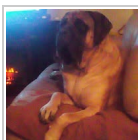
