Donald Allison -- Kankakee Donald L. Allison, 61, of Kankakee, passed away peacefully Friday (Feb. 9, 2007) at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday. Rev. Steve Goodin will officiate. Cremation rites will be accorded. Memorials may be made for his granddaughters' college education. Mr. Allison worked as Financial Control and Support Analyst for the U.S. Postal Service for 34 years. He was born April 23, 1945, in Danville, the son of Richard and Evelyn Mortisen Allison. He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War. He married the former Sandra LaRoche Aug. 26, 1967 in Alvin, Ill. He coached the Azzarelli Colts for many years. He was a member of the Kankakee Elks Lodge, and past president of the Kankakee Valley Pool League, where he played on Wednesday nights for 20 years. He worked out at Gold's Gym daily and was an avid fisherman for over 30 years. He liked to golf and play pool, and being a barber was more of a hobby than a profession. He loved spending time with his two granddaughters more than anything else, especially swimming with them. Donnie's number one priority was his family. Surviving are his wife of 40 years, Sandy; his best friend and son, Terry, and his daughter-in-law, Anita, whom he considered a daughter; and his pride and joy, two granddaughters, Stephanie (9) and Leighann (5) Allison. Donnie considered Sandy's family as his own. Deceased are his parents; two sisters, Kay Baker and Darlene Smith; and one brother, Daniel Allison.

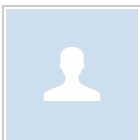

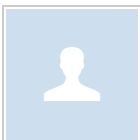
