Donald L. Benjamin, 73, of Bourbonnais, died Wednesday (Dec. 17, 2008) in the Provena St. Mary's Hospital emergency room, from a sudden illness. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley, where he was a member. Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the American Heart Association. Mr. Benjamin retired from General Foods after 37 years and currently worked part-time at Carson Pirie Scott.
