Donald R. "Don" Glenzinski, 67, of Kankakee, passed away on Tuesday, December 26, 2017 at Northwestern Memorial Hospital in Chicago. He was born on April 16, 1950, in Kankakee, to Eugene and Barbara Kertzman Glenzinski. Don married Susan M. McCullough on August 7, 1971 at Immaculate Conception in Kankakee.

Don graduated in 1968 from Bishop McNamara High School. He attended Kankakee Community College. Don served in the United States Army 82nd Airborne Division during the Vietnam War.

Don was a retired carpenter. He retired from Kankakee School District 111 after 22 years of service.

He was a lifelong member of St. Patrick Church. He was a member of Knights of Columbus and the 558 Carpenters Local. Don was a 22 year heart transplant survivor.
