



Dr. Donald E Krause

November 16, 1955 - December 2, 2024

Donald E. Krause, DDS, age 69 of Bourbonnais, passed away on Monday, December 2, 2024, at his home following a brief illness. He was born November 16, 1955, at St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, the son of Walter and June Krause.

Dr. Krause opened a private dental practice in Kankakee in 1982. He retired in 2023, after serving the community and his patients for over 40 years.

Dr. Krause was a 1973 graduate of Westview High School in Kankakee and a 1977 graduate of Illinois Wesleyan University. He completed his professional education at Northwestern University earning his dental degree in 1982.

Dr. Krause was a member of College Church of the Nazarene, Bourbonnais. He performed missionary dental work on multiple occasions in the Galapagos Islands serving children and involved in charitable work for all those in need.

Surviving is his wife, Delores of Bourbonnais; one son, Ryan Krause, two daughters and son-in-law, Emily Krause, Dr. Laurie (Hymie) Gauthier; one brother and sister-in-law, Dr. David (Rebecca) Krause of Bourbonnais; and three grandchildren.

Dr. Krause is preceded in death by his parents; and one son, Andrew Krause.

Dr. Krause was a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon Fraternity, the Kiwanis Club of Kankakee, the Kankakee County Dental Society, and the American Dental Association.

Dr. Krause was an attending staff member at Presence St. Mary's Hospital and Riverside Medical Center, both of Kankakee.

Visitation will be from 9:00 a.m. until the 11:00 a.m. service on Friday, December 6, 2024, at College Church of the Nazarene, Bourbonnais. Cremation rites will be accorded following the service. Arrangements are by Clancy-Gernon Funeral Homes, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to family wishes.
