Visitation for Donald "Spids" L. Kyrouac, 79, of Bradley, will be from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Bradley.

Burial will be in Maternity BVM Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to St. Joseph Catholic Church. He died Monday (May 7, 2012) at his home.

Mr. Kyrouac was the retired owner/operator of LK Bottled Gas Inc., and recently was a courier for Alverno Labs. He was born Sept. 12, 1932, in Bourbonnais, the son of Leo and Gladys Chantome Kyrouac.
