Donald J. Longtin, 56, of Kankakee, passed away Sunday (Dec. 8, 2013) at his home following an extended illness.

Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, also at the funeral home. Father Dan Belanger will officiate. Cremation rites will be accorded following the services.
