Donald M. "Don" Marcotte, age 79, of Manteno and formerly of St. Anne, passed away Tuesday, August 23, 2016 at River North of Bradley.

Don was born September 25, 1936 in Kankakee, the son of John D. & Fleta Smith Marcotte.

He married Barbara J. Koloski September 12, 1959. She preceded in him death February of 2001. On September 26, 2008, Don married Barbara J. LaMore.

Don retired from the U.S. Post Office in 2000. He had been a rural carrier in St. Anne. He had also farmed and owned/operated Marcotte Towing in St. Anne. Don had also been a welder at Roper and AO Smith.

He was a veteran of the US Army.
