Donald J. O'Connor, 67, of Kankakee, died Saturday (Sept. 9, 2006) at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tuesday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, where he was a member. Father Charles Wheeler will officiate. Burial will be in St. James Cemetery, Irwin.
