She was born Nov. 7, 1919, in Palm Beach, Fla., the daughter of Cecil and Nora Gallagher Donnelly. Her husband, Dr. J. Thomas Baldwin, whom she married June 10, 1947, at Holy Name Cathedral, Chicago, died Aug. 31, 2001. She was a 1941 graduate of Florida State University and a member of Alpha Gamma Delta. She was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church and the CCW. She was also a member of the Tuesday Book Review and the Kankakee Woman's Club. She was a former member of St. Edwards Parish in Palm Beach. She was a volunteer for many years at St. Mary's Hospital and for Meals on Wheels. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Timothy and Beth Baldwin, Patrick and Michelle Baldwin, all of Bourbonnais; two daughters and one son-in-law, Margaret and Daniel Koziol of Park Ridge, Mary Baldwin of Sherman Oaks, Calif.; and nine grandchildren, Michael, Katie, Teresa, and Jonathan Baldwin, Peggy, Ame, and Andy Baldwin, John and Nora Koziol. Deceased are her parents and one sister, Kathryn Ryan.
