One granddaughter, Kathleen Anderson; two brothers, Archie and Beaucie Francouer; and one sister, Jeannette Rinaldo, are deceased. She was a former volunteer for the American Red Cross. Mrs. LaFond was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, Beaverville, where she was a sacristan and choir member. She was also a member of the Sodality of St. Mary's and was named Woman of the Year in 1996. She enjoyed cooking, reading, crossword puzzles,
