Dorothy Jean "Dottie" (Buckles) Neill, 82, of Kankakee, went to be with the Lord at 12:15 p.m. Saturday (July 31, 2010) after a long illness. She was born Oct. 10, 1927, in Muncie, Ind., the daughter of Maurice and Harriet Fletcher Buckles. She attended Olivet Nazarene College (now University) in Bourbonnais as a music major and was an active member and soloist in the Orpheus Choir. Here, she met and married Snowden Albert Neill Sr. Feb. 1, 1946, at Olivet Nazarene College. They continued to live in Kankakee, and she went on to receive a licensed practical nurse degree, a field in which she worked until she was disabled in 1974. From childhood until college, she was a member of the South Side Nazarene Church in Muncie and was, until her passing, an active member of Immanuel Baptist Church in Kankakee. She enjoyed singing in the church choir and participating in the Bible study groups throughout the years. Dorothy is survived by her husband, Snowden Albert "Budd" Neill Sr., 86, of Kankakee; four daughters, Debbie and Jerry Wilson, of Herscher, Alma Jill Neill of Pontiac, Shelley Marie Neill of Victor, Mont., and Pamela Sue and Dr. Rick Marx, of Phoenix, Ariz.; one son, Snowden Albert "Snowie" Jr. and Dawn Neill of Ridgecrest, Calif.; three grandsons, two granddaughters, 13 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandson; two sisters, Patricia Jeffers of Muncie, and Wanda Nichols of Indianapolis, Ind.; and two brothers, James Buckles of Goshen, Ind., and Paul Buckles of Muncie.
