Dr. Edward J. Setlik, 83, of Bradley, died Thursday (Oct. 29, 2009) at Provena Heritage Village, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Bradley, where he was a member. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais.
