



Dr. Harold Jordan

February 4, 1925 - March 7, 2010

Memorial visitation for Dr. Harold A. Jordan, 85, of Bourbonnais, will be from 5 p.m. Wednesday until the 8 p.m. memorial service at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. The Rev. John Franklin will officiate. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or Hines VA Hospital. He died Sunday (March 7, 2010) at his home. Dr. Jordan was a doctor of chiropractic for 38 years, the first chiropractor in Bourbonnais. He was born Feb. 4, 1925, in Kankakee, the son of Otis L. and Nell Dawney Jordan. His wife, the former Frances Ruth Osterhoff, whom he married March 15, 1955, in Del Ray Beach, Fla., died Oct. 13, 2005. He was a pilot in the Army Air Corp during World War II. He was a current member of the American Legion and a former longtime member of the Lions and Elks. Surviving are four sons and two daughters-in-law, Harry and Mary Jordan of Batavia, Mark Jordan of Bourbonnais, Roger Jordan of Aurora, Robert and Jennifer Jordan of Elk Grove Village; three daughters and two sons-in-law, Jacqueline Cook of Wisconsin, Jolene Jordan-Hoover and Dave Hoover of South Carolina, Karen Jordan-Flores and Ed Flores of Elmhurst; 19 grandchildren and one great-grandchild. He was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters and two brothers.
