Kenneth O. Norgaard -- Kankakee Kenneth O. Norgaard, DDS, 83, of Kankakee, died Thursday (March 22, 2007) at Harborside Healthcare Rehab and Nursing Center in Westlake, Ohio. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. today at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Monday at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church. Rev. Dennis Settles will officiate. Cremation rites will be accorded following the Mass. Private inurnment will be held at Sts. Peter & Paul Cemetery in Herscher. Memorials may be made to St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, where he was a member, or to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. Dr. Norgaard was a dentist with his own practice in Kankakee for 35 years. He retired in 1985. He was born Sept. 18, 1923, in Kankakee, the son of Charles T. and Lucile Darr Norgaard. He was a graduate of Herscher High School, the University of Illinois Dental College in Chicago, and in 1955 was one of the dentists who initiated fluoride treatments at local schools. He served in the U.S. Air Force from March 1943 to February 1946. He was the former president of the Kankakee District Dental Society. He enjoyed bridge, golf and crossword puzzles. Surviving are his wife, the former Ardelle Ruder, whom he married Feb. 6, 1945, at St. Margaret Mary Church in Herscher; one son, K. Scott Norgaard of Parker, Colo.; four daughters, Constance and James Pries of Minneapolis, Minn., Patrice and Randall Fortin of Avon Lake, Ohio, Jeanne Tramm and Michael Hooker of Asheville, N.C., Jill and Larry Roberts of Adrian, Mich.; 10 grandchildren, Alex Pries, Alissa Pries, Lt.
