Dr. Stanley Tikusis -- Manteno Visitation for Dr. Stanley Tikusis, 86, of Manteno, formerly of Beecher and Roseland, will be from 5-9 p.m. Tuesday, with a 7 p.m. wake service, at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Manteno. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Wednesday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Manteno, where he was a member. Rev. Ed Grotovsky will officiate. Burial will be in St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery, Manteno. He died Saturday (April 22, 2006) at Provena Heritage Village, Kankakee. Dr. Tikusis was a dentist, and he ran his own practice in Roseland and later in Glenwood. He was born Sept. 27, 1919, in Chicago, the son of John and Josephine Ziogas Tikusis. He served as a lieutenant in the U.S. Navy. He was a Kiwanian for many years and also belonged to the Moose in Roseland. He enjoyed reading, especially about nutrition and body chemistry. Surviving are his wife, the former Mary Synesael, whom he married Nov. 29, 1944; six sons and three daughters-in-law, Frederic Tikusis of Atlanta, Ga., Thomas and Jean Tikusis of Helenville, Wis., Edward Tikusis of Conyers, Ga., Michael and Cindy Tikusis of West Bend, Wis., David and Lisa Tikusis of Beecher, Daniel Tikusis of Englewood, Colo.; four daughters and two sons-in-law, Janet Tikusis of Tampa, Fla., Theresa Kurth of Homewood, Julie and Rich Kuse of Manhattan, Linda and Steven Lehman of St. Petersburg, Fla.; and 15 grandchildren. Deceased are one brother, Rev. Vincent Tikusis; and two sisters, Julia Tikusis and Anne Stoppel.
