



Dr. Wilbur H. Miller, Jr.

July 20, 1930 - January 6, 2010

Visitation for Dr. Wilbur H. "Wib" Miller Jr., 79, of Kankakee, will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church in Kankakee. Father Dennis Settles will officiate. Burial will be in Limestone Cemetery. Memorials may be made to Bishop McNamara Catholic High School Huddle Club or to The Salvation Army. He died Wednesday (Jan. 6, 2010) at Riverside Medical Center. Dr. Miller was a retired physician and former director of emergency medicine at Riverside Medical Center for 22 years. He was born July 20, 1930, in Harrisburg, Pa., the son of Wilbur H. Sr. and Frances Burkholder Miller. He was a founder and partner with Pediatrics LTD. He served in the U.S. Army Medical Corp. He was a member of the local, state and national Medical Association, a graduate of Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pa., and received his medical degree from Jefferson Medical School in Philadelphia, Pa. He was a member of the 100 Club and American College of Emergency Physicians. Surviving are his wife, the former Rosemary Sosnoski, whom he married June 27, 1956, in South Bend, Ind.; one son and daughter-in-law, Brian and Charlene Miller of Kankakee; three daughters and one son-in-law, Carol and Thomas St. Peter of Kankakee, Linda Miller of Glen Ellyn, Laurie Miller of Wheaton; seven grandchildren, Thomas Jr. (Angie) St. Peter, Jenna (Mike) McCabe, Ashley (Bill) Haley, Zachary Miller, Michael Miller, Alexandra Miller and Samantha Miller; four great-grandchildren, Tea Rose St. Peter, Liv Bella St. Peter, Tristan
