Duane James Maue; age 78, of St. Anne, IL, passed away Saturday August 18, 2018, at his home surrounded by family.

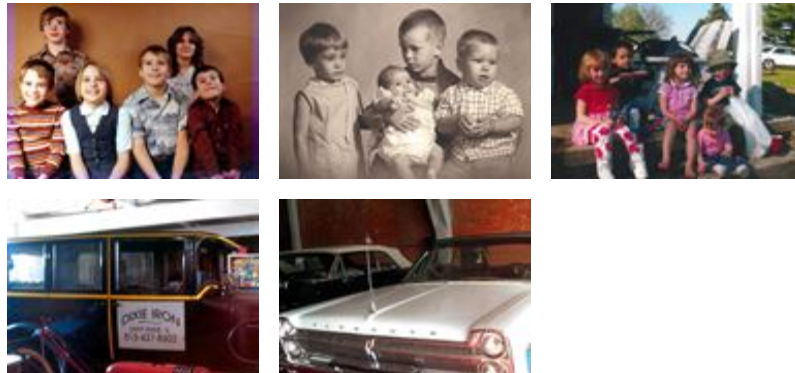
