Memorial visitation for Duane S. Sanor, 82, of Bourbonnais, will be held from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, and from 9:30 a.m. Friday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church until the 10 a.m. celebration of the memorial Mass. He died Monday (June 22, 2009) at his home. Mr. Sanor retired from Kroehler Manufacturing, where he was a supervisor. He later worked at Alan Shepard Grade School as a custodian. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving in the South Pacific and a member of the Bradley American Legion Post 0766 and a lifetime member of the Bradley VFW Post 6502.
