July 15, 1923 - April 29, 2005

Earl E. Frerichs, 81, of Herscher, longtime farmer, died Friday (April 29, 2005) in the emergency room at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 2-6 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, West Kankakee, and from 9 a.m. Monday at St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church, Herscher, until the 10 a.m. celebration of the funeral Mass. Rev. Ronald Hart will officiate. Burial will be in Sts. Mary and Joseph Cemetery, Chebanse. Memorials may be made to St. Margaret Mary Church, Herscher, where he was a member; or to the donor's choice. Mr. Frerichs was a retired Herscher area farmer. He and his family were named the Journal's 1984 Farm Family of the Year. He had also worked for the ASC office for 20 years. He was a former Otto Township Fire Department trustee for 30 years. He was born July 15, 1923, in Danforth, the son of Edward and Clara Kremer Frerichs. Surviving are his wife, the former Doreen Scanlon, of Herscher, whom he married Aug. 11, 1948, at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Kankakee; three sons and two daughters-in-law, Brian Frerichs of Limestone Twp., Scott and Cindy Frerichs of Herscher, Craig and Elizabeth Frerichs of Clifton; one daughter and son-in-law, Colleen and Robert Schultz of Herscher; one sister, Dorothy Berg of Bloomington; one brother and sister-in-law, John and Bernita Frerichs of Danforth; 10 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. One grandson, Austin Frerichs; and one brother-in-law, Chet Berg, are deceased. He was a 1940 graduate of Gilman High School. Mr. Frerichs served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. He was a radio gunner with the 8th Air Force,

flying 35 missions over Germany. He was a member of the Vintage Squadron which meets at the Kankakee VFW and the Chebanse American Legion. He was also a member of the Moose. He loved to travel and had seen all 50 states.

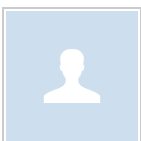
