October 12, 1929 - October 13, 2010

Earl W. "Pops" Russow, 81, of Kankakee, died Wednesday (Oct. 13, 2010) at his residence. Private visitation and services will be held. Cremation rites have been accorded by the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Crematory, west Kankakee. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or to St. Paul Lutheran Church, Kankakee. Mr. Russow owned Earl's Auto Sales in Bradley during the '70s and '80s. He later worked at other auto sales firms. He was also part of a trio called "City Slickers" for many years. He was born Oct. 12, 1929, in Kankakee, the son of Henry and Loretta Spies Russow. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, serving during World War II. Surviving are his wife, the former Barbara Guenette, of Kankakee, whom he married March 11, 1955; three sons and two daughters-in-law, Jesse and Sherry Russow, of Bourbonnais, Michael and Jane Russow, of Phoenix, Ariz., and Mark Russow, of Kankakee; one daughter, Diana Russow, of Bradley; 10 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren; one brother and two sisters-in-law, Kenny and Shirley Russow, of Kankakee, and Kay Russow, of Tampa, Fla., and two brothers-in-law, Jerry Guenette and Duane Guenette, both of Kankakee. He was preceded in death by his parents; two sons, Brian and Shane Russow; and one brother, Dale Russow.
