Visitation for Edward Anthony Januski, 90, of Phoenix, Ariz., formerly of Kankakee, will be from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. He was born Feb. 6, 1919, in Kankakee, the son of Alexander and Alexandria "Alice" Januski. His wife, the former Frances Ruth Jones, whom he married Sept. 6, 1948, is deceased. He served in the U.S. Army from 1940 to 1945, achieving the rank of first Sergeant and was the recipient of the Bronze Star. Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, Kevin and Laurie Januski of Bourbonnais, Steven and Betty Januski of Aroma Park; one daughter and son-in-law, Judi and Jim Baldrige of Phoenix; nine grandchildren; and one sister and brother-in-law, Lucille and Melvin "Bud" Menard of Bradley. One son, Dennis; his parents; four brothers, Walter, Frank, Charles and John Januski; and two sisters, Stella Chouinard and Theresa Burnett, are deceased.
