Einar A. Hult, 79, of Kankakee, died Friday (April 13, 2007) at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. Monday until the 7 p.m. services at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. Father Dennis Settles will officiate. Cremation rites will be accorded following the services. Memorials may be made to Good Shepherd Manor, Momence. Einar Hult had a 64-year career in the floor covering business which began at Goldblatt Brothers in Chicago in 1943. He moved to Kankakee in 1951 as manager of the floor covering department at the Fair Store. He opened his own floor covering business "Hult Floor Covering" on Court and Washington in Kankakee in 1961. In 1995 the business relocated to Kennedy Drive and changed its name to "Hult Interior Design." He worked until the present time at that location. He was born June 13, 1927, in Chicago, the son of Frederick and Emma Hult, who immigrated to the United States from Sweden. He was a prior member of the Kankakee Jaycees, the Elks, Dale Carnegie Alumni Association, of which he was a past president, Kankakee Home Builders Association, the Kankakee Chamber of Commerce and the Kankakee Downtown Business Association. Surviving are his wife, the former Marjorie A. Peto, whom he married Aug. 21, 1948, in Chicago; two sons, Dr. Frederick E. Hult of McHenry, Capt. Stephen C. Hult of St. Louis, Mo.; two daughters, Teri Hult and special friend Earl Overby of Kankakee, Marjorie Milone and husband Bruce Milone of Bourbonnais; four grandchildren, Erin and Tyler Milone, Victoria and Andrew Hult; one brother and sister-in-law, Eric and Millie

Hult of Columbus, Ind.; and numerous nieces and nephews. Deceased are his parents; one sister, Elsie; and one brother, Ivar.
