



## Elaine P. Mulligan

May 30, 1920 - December 29, 2011

Visitation for Elaine P. Mulligan, 91, of Bradley, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Tuesday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. The Rev. Anthony Nugent will officiate. Interment will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Mrs. Mulligan worked at Bear Brand Hosiery Company, where she was a steam iron kaumographer. She owned and ran the Antique Parlor in Bradley. She was also a timekeeper at the Roper Corporation. She worked in the office at Montgomery Ward, the state's attorney's office, circuit clerk's office in Kankakee County and for two Kankakee attorneys.

She was born May 30, 1920, in Bradley, the daughter of John T. and Della Dion Wright. Her first husband, Clifford E. Sederstrand, whom she married in September of 1941, died during World War II on June 14, 1944. Her second husband, Glenn E. Mulligan, whom she married in 1947, died Feb. 1, 2002. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley.
