July 24, 1914 - December 22, 2007

Eleanor M. Geiger, 93, a lifelong Bradley resident, and most recently a resident of Heritage Woods in Manteno, died Saturday (Dec. 22, 2007) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee.
