Mrs. Hebert baked and decorated cakes for 30 years, was a former beautician, and was a former employee of the Joliet Arsenal and Florence Stove Co. She was born Nov. 16, 1918, in Kankakee, the daughter of Fred and Frances Buck Hengl. Her husband, Adrian A. Hebert, whom she married July 3, 1948, at St. Mary's Catholic Church, in Kankakee, died July 6, 1995. She was a member of Maternity BVM Catholic Church and the CCW. She traveled with her daughter, going on 26 cruises and visiting 13 national parks and 41 states. She enjoyed casino trips, sewing and crafts. Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, Chester and May Hebert, of Bourbonnais; one daughter, Frances Hebert of Bourbonnais; and many nieces and nephews.
