Emilie Chaplinski, age 92, of Bourbonnais passed away on Friday, December 10, 2021 in Kankakee. She was born June 6, 1929 in Nurnburg, Germany, the daughter of Hans & Katherine (Nefzger) Boscher. Emilie married Donald Chaplinski on November 15, 1952 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. He preceded her in death on December 12, 1993.

Emilie came to the United States in January 1952 and became a United States citizen on June 12, 1957.

She was a parishioner of Maternity B.V.M. Catholic Church and a member of the Kankakee Needleworkers Guild and The Quiltmakers of Kankakee. Emilie retired from Bunge Edible Oil.

Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, Randall & Patricia Chaplinski of Bourbonnais; one sister and brother-in-law, Inge & Gerhard Klupp of Nurnberg, Germany; two grandchildren, Claire Chaplinski (Michael Saineghi) and Scott (Carla) Chaplinski, all of Bourbonnais; and three great-grandchildren, Vera Saineghi, Lila Saineghi, and Melody Chaplinski. In addition to her husband, Donald Chaplinski, Emilie was preceded in death by her parents.
