E. Ray Stanley -- Chebanse E. Ray Stanley, 63, of Chebanse, died Wednesday (Oct. 17, 2007) in the emergency room at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee, after a sudden illness. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais, where services will be held at 10 a.m. Monday. Graveside services will follow at noon at Chapel Lawn Memorial Gardens in Schererville, Ind. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. Mr. Stanley recently retired from Indiana Harbor Belt Railroad. He had also worked in construction with Hayes Construction Company.
