February 13, 1916 - March 31, 2009

Esther Williams Tur of Tucson, Ariz., formerly of Kankakee, died Tuesday (March 31, 2009) at the age of 93. She lived a full and productive life beginning as a home cook for Gov. Len Small and his family of Kankakee. She then worked at the Joliet Arsenal Ammunition Plant and for Kankakee Fibre Drum Co., as a screen printer, from which she retired at the age of 64. She enjoyed cooking, traveling, gambling, crocheting and playing cards. She led a very active and happy life. She was the matriarch of the Williams family and grandma to all.
