Evangeline "Angie" Anton, 92, of Kankakee, died Friday (April 13, 2007) at Northwest Community Hospital in Arlington Heights. She was a volunteer at Provena St. Mary's Hospital Gift Shop. She enjoyed baking, especially Greek pastries. She loved her kids, grandkids and great-grandkids. Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, George and Joan Anton of Darien; one daughter and son-in-law, Angie and George Anagnostopoulos of Arlington Heights; three grandchildren, Cary and Wendee Anagnostopoulos, Tom Anton, and Dana Anton; and two great-granddaughters, Olivia and Ava Anagnostopoulos. Deceased are her parents; three brothers, William, Andrew, and Phillip; and three sisters, Stavia and Georgia Athanasopoulos, and Collette Poulos.
